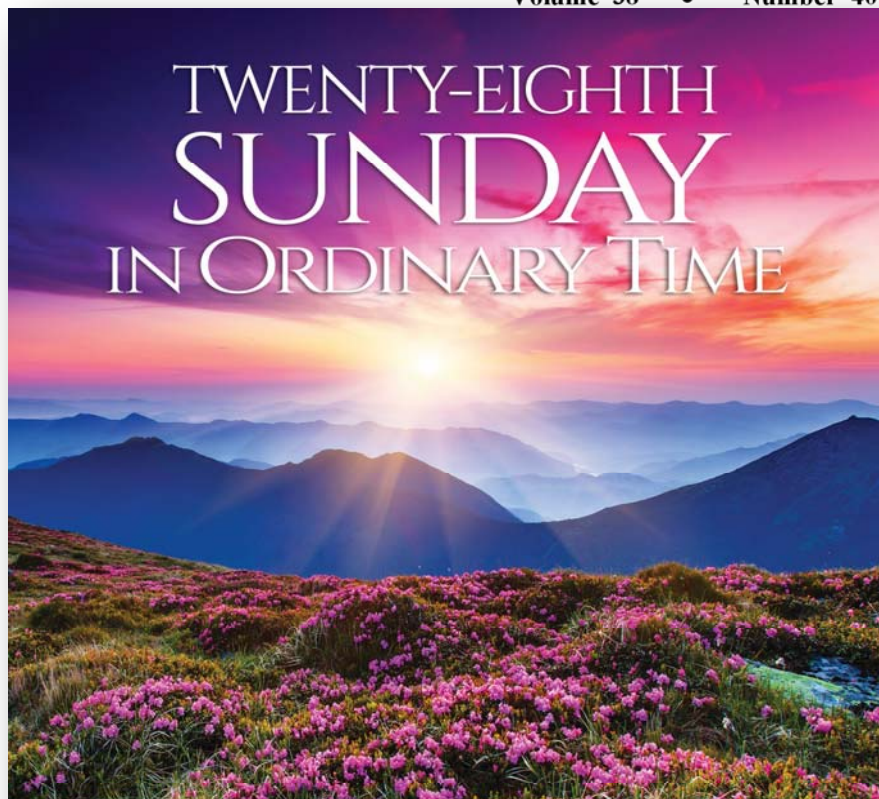

CONSIDERATION OF OUR CHRISTIAN COMMITMENT: ORDINARY MINISTRY & LIFE

This Sunday the Scriptures begin with the beautiful words from the Book of Wisdom: "I prayed and prudence was given me; I pleaded and the spirit of Wisdom came to me...All good things together came to me in her company..." Praying for wisdom and seeking to be accompanied by wisdom is a beautiful reading for this time of the year when so many of our formation programs have begun again. As I have said many times, formation is an ongoing process, beginning at baptism and ending when God calls us to himself. It is so good to see all that is happening in the parish as we have begun another pastoral year.

Our RCIA Team had a retreat weekend as we began the Inquiry sessions.



While we will have prayer days for all Inquirers as the year progresses, this was just for those RCIA team members who were able to attend and it was held at the William J. Kelley Retreat Center in Bay St. Louis. We have a good number of Inquirers who have been so faithful in attending and know this will be a good year.

As we began another year of formation with our youth, some of our catechists were recognized by Bishop Muench and were given certificates of Recognition for 10 years of

Our Children's Choir came together and began



practicing again when our Parish School of Religion classes resumed toward the end of September. There was a good turnout of students who practice usually at 5:30 on Wednesday after the 4:30 session and before the 6:30 session. **New choir members are always welcome. All you have to do is show up at 5:30 on Wednesdays.**

Our Immaculate Student Ministry also began meeting in the large parish hall on Wednesday evenings as one combined group – Jr. High and High School. However beginning this week, now that the Youth Center has been



refurbished, they will divide and begin meeting there. **Beginning this Tuesday, October 13, ENCOUNTER** middle school group will move to Tuesday's from 6-7:30 p.m., and on **Thursday, October 15th, we start THURSDAY NIGHT LIVE** for our high schoolers from


7-8:30 p.m. All of these youth meetings will be held in the recently renovated youth rooms, on the north side of the Pavilion. We thank **Kevin Acord** who has been working primarily with the high school division and **Amanda Milton** who will be working with the middle school division. While Kevin and Amanda will work together, they will have separate meetings for the two groups on different evenings, and will both be assisted by **Bridget Stringfellow**. Occasionally all the youth will take part in certain activities such as World Youth Day, Abbey Fest and March for Life. We thank Kevin, Amanda and Bridget and all who have been working with them, as well as the youth who have helped our group grow from 2 or 3 the first night to well over twenty by now. We look forward to great things from them. They are also looking for adults who really wish to help work with these students a few hours a week. 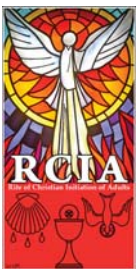

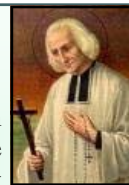
