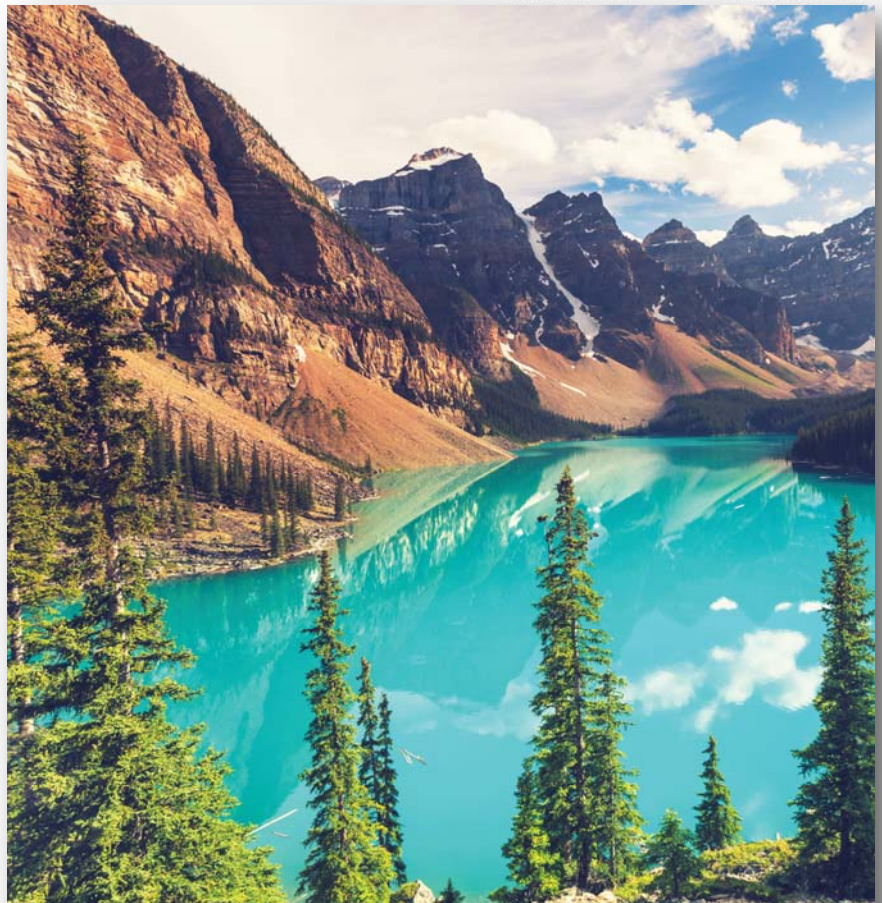

## CONSIDERATION OF OUR CHRISTIAN COMMITMENT: ORDINARY TIME

In our second reading today, St. Paul reminds us that we were called to freedom,...freedom to serve one another through love. It is nice to see this freedom expressed many ways throughout the year and in special ways these summer months.

**Handmade Reserved signs are a special addition to the church.** Two weeks ago when we had the special celebration for Marriage Anniversaries, I was both surprised and pleased to walk into the church and see new reserved signs placed across the ends of the pews. They are a special gift from four special parishioners. They are made of cloth and hang across the back of the pew so as not to damage the pews and come both in red and green. The 55 reserved signs are embroidered to say either "Reserved," "Reserved for Special Needs," or "Reserved for Ushers." They are really nice and are a very useful and beautiful addition to the



church. They were made by **Barbara Williams, Kay Keen, Toni Tubb and Anne Watson.** We thank them for sharing their time and talents with us.

**Soul Core is the latest ministry here at Immaculate Conception.** It involves prayer, exercise and fellowship.



There were twenty two participants for the first session last Friday evening, and Amanda Milton, coordinator for the ministry, hopes to have two events in July. There was a lot of interest expressed by participants of possibly making this a regular ministry and expanding the program. We are grateful to the four Soul Core leaders from LaPlace who came to help us get started. Please

check the bulletin for upcoming gatherings of Soul Core, and hopefully seeing it become regularly scheduled here at Immaculate Conception.

**Launch holds an art exhibit in the Faith Formation Center.** Joseph Bergan attended the art exhibit and



reception held by Launch last week. Launch was organized by Dr. Chantelle Varnado and serves in many ways. It is a Therapeutic Preschool held in the Faith Formation Center. The half-day (9am-12pm) preschool enables children with disabilities to receive daily speech, occupational, and/or physical therapy while being exposed to a preschool curriculum.

The "teachers" are the therapists! There are 2, 3, and 5 day programs available. They also have Outpatient Therapy where areas of expertise include cerebral palsy, autism, developmental delay, fine and gross motor skills, sensory integration, handwriting, articulation, expressive language, receptive language, voice, fluency, social skills, augmentative and alternative communication, feeding and swallowing. They also wish to minister Religious Education for school-aged children with disabilities that are unable to attend traditional religious education classes and are interested in receiving religious education. Parents can call Chantelle at 238-1741.

**The art camp was headed by Cheri Fry and was designed to address speech and language needs of children with a variety of disabilities** and for typical children to serve as peer models. During the four-day camp, the children completed three clay pieces, a canvas, a sculpture, and a stick project. The art show was held at the conclusion of the camp to enable the children to share their work with their families and the community. Some of these children are not able to attend traditional summer camps due to the level of their disability. Having a camp at Launch enables the children's needs to be met by therapists and staff trained in their area of disability. We are happy to host them in the Faith Formation Center.
