## CONSIDERATION OF OUR CHRISTIAN COMMITMENT: ORDINARY MUSIC 🎵 🎵

**In the second reading today, the Apostle Paul speaks of Abraham who journeyed to an unknown place, but trusted in the God who called him.** All of us are called, sometimes each day, from our comfort zones, our places of comfort to places that might not be as well-known and “comfortable” to us. As St. Paul says, we walk by faith and not by sight. This move might for some be a movement into a ministry to which they feel called. For others it might mean the move to another stage of life – marriage, a new job, the priesthood, or retirement. As long as we live, there will be calls to move from what is known to other pastures, and we pray that we might always be ready to walk by faith, even when we don’t see the road or final outcome all that clearly.

**We have some moves coming up that you might have heard of through the grapevine.** Simon and Margaret



**Pfeil and Leo** will be moving later this month to DePere, Wisconsin. **Dr. Simon** has received his doctorate and a position teaching at St. Norbert’s College, and they will need to be there on the 18<sup>th</sup> of August, so they will be leaving the week of the 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Because they have been such a part of our parish worship over the years, we wanted to give them an appropriate send off.** In addition to the Sunday Liturgies, they have assisted with so many weddings, funerals, Children’s Choir – you name it, they have been there, ready to contribute for the good of us all. They have also become close friends with the choir and other musicians in the parish. We thought about different possibilities, and what seemed to be the best for Simon and Margaret was to be able to participate with the choir in the Eucharist, celebrating the Assumption of Mary into Heaven, on Monday, August 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. The Assumption is a Holyday as it always is, but because it falls on a Monday this year, it will not be a Holyday of Obligation. We felt, though not obligated, many might wish to participate in this 7:00 p.m. Eucharist in honor of Mary’s Assumption, and after join us all in the parish hall for a going away reception for Simon, Margaret and their son, Leo. All are invited.

In preparation for their moving, Simon and Margaret have been taking care of providing for the parish, arranging that

we might have new cantors for Sunday Liturgies, Weddings and Funerals, and perhaps you may have heard some of them already as they get ready for their new roles in the parish, as they join our present cantors, **Glen Forbes** and **Greg Oivanki**.

Leading the choir again will be **Kathy Newcomb** who led the



choir for a number of years until she gave the role to Margaret, thinking she and her husband Mark would soon be moving out of state. Happily for us, this didn’t happen and Kathy will begin leading the choir again in September when she and Mark return from vacation days. I want to share with you a note she wrote me back then. *“Words cannot adequately express what my ministry with the choir has meant to me and my family. I joined the choir upon our arrival in Denham Springs in 1977. After a short while, I took the director’s position. However, God was not ready for me to assume that role and I left to work on myself and raise a family. Along with Tonda Delahoussaye and Christine Bergeron, we started a Children’s Choir. The blessing from that endeavor was two talented ladies that now lead choirs – Melissa McKee and Margaret Davis Pfeil. I later came back to lead the adult choir...I gained more than I ever gave and will always cherish the love that I felt in this ministry...”* We will be very happy to welcome Kathy back as choir director this September.

**I announced it at the daily Eucharist, and you may have heard that the last week of July, Father Robert Marcell, pastor of Immaculate Conception 1987-1994, fell and broke his hip.** He had just moved to South Side Gardens Community this past Friday with the great help of Father David and is currently at Our Lady of the Lake Hospital recovering from surgery on his hip. Let us keep him in our prayers.

**We received a word of thanks from CommUnity Hands for helping them hold their annual fundraiser here.**

They sold 1,300 plates of fish and raised \$9,000, which will go right back into the community in terms of assistance to the poor and needy. CommUnity Hands is a two-fold grace – assistance to the poor, but also churches coming together and working together. It’s beautiful! 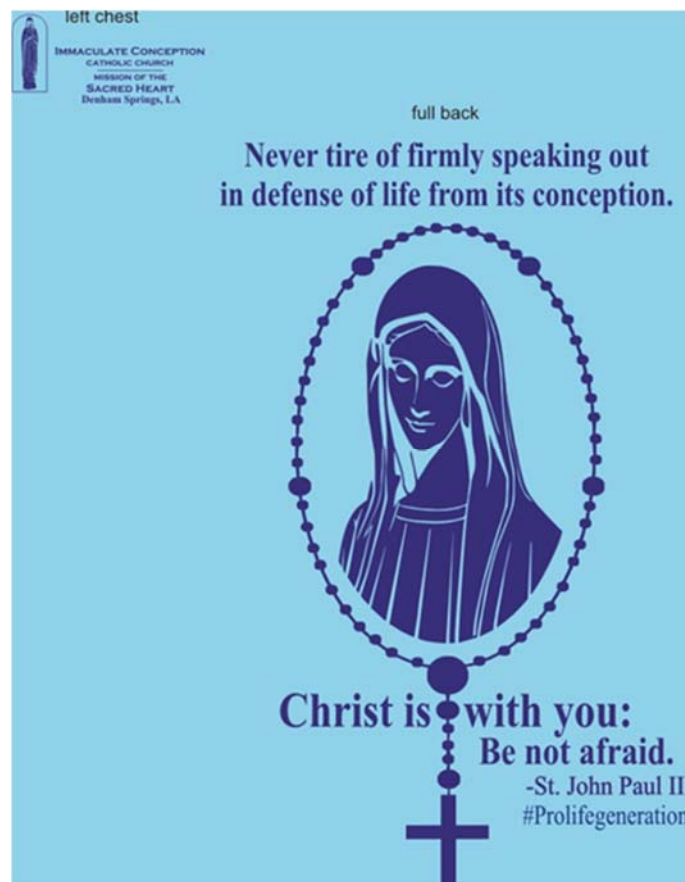

**The Financial Report on the left shows the financial aspect of parish operations for the Fiscal Year which ended June 30, 2016.** I thank Ferdie Genre and the Finance Council for their help through the year, and Michelle Holmes for her work with this on a daily basis.

At left, under income, I have placed under other for simplicities sake, donations, Mass offerings, interest earned on savings, etc.

At left, when we take money from savings, it is counted as income, and below under expenses, when we place it in savings from the operating budget, it is considered an expense, because it is no longer in the annual operating budget.

At left we have again included all salaries together for simplicities sake, and under other I have included household expenses, liturgical expenses, books, bulletins, seminars and conferences.

This is our monthly donation to the Diocese based on income over a three year period. This helps pay for Diocesan services we all benefit from, here and throughout the Diocese.

Under other we have included, RCIA, Adult Formation programs, Youth Ministry, socials and receptions, Sunday nursery, and other forms of outreach.

This is self-explanatory and under other we have included janitorial supplies, vehicle expense.

This would include the new pews, floors in church and some of the improvements which were above regular maintenance this past fiscal year.

As mentioned above, when we place money in savings from our operational budget, it is considered an expense, though we still own the money. **I have tried to make a two page budget simple and easy to read by combining line items, and explaining it at the same time.** We thank you for your generous support through the year which helps make our parish life and ministry possible.
