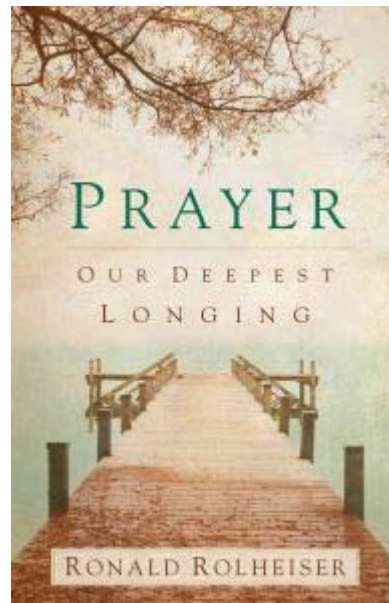

The Mini Health Fair was a heart event focusing on the heart since February is heart month. Because of the



flood, the traditional large health fair usually held in the fall was cancelled, but this one, focusing on the heart with all sorts of screenings was well attended. We thank Stephanie Gaudin, our parish nurse, for her involvement in the well being of parishioners.

Fr. Philip is preaching at all Sunday Liturgies this weekend and will offer Mission presentations Monday- Wednesday at 7:00 p.m.

The talks will be within the context of a Prayer Service which he will lead, except at the last evening, Wednesday, when he will preach within a 7:00 p.m. Eucharist. **We hope all will be able to join us.** With the Mission two weeks before Lent begins, it will be a beautiful way to prepare for a really good and graced Lent. He preached the retreat for the priests of our Diocese two years ago, and right after the retreat I was on the Internet trying to get him to come here. I understand this year he is preaching the retreat for the priests of the Archdiocese of New Orleans. We are happy to welcome him to Immaculate Conception.

Children’s Church was scheduled to begin September 11, and on August 9th, I wrote a letter and sent a calendar for the 2016-2017 year to all the dedicated workers who minister with Children’s Church. Of course, the flood waters probably arrived at our homes before the letters. Now that the halls are completely redone and are being used, it seemed like the First Sunday of Lent, March 5, would be a good day to resume Children’s Church so our young parishioners would not miss this ministry for a whole year. Materials have been ordered and all is ready to begin March 5th at the 11:00 Eucharist. **If you are interested in helping**

with Children’s Church or have any questions about it, please give me a call at 665-5359. Children’s Church is a Liturgy of the Word for young parishioners roughly in pre-K through 5th grade. They are dismissed after the Opening Prayer and return for the Liturgy of the Eucharist during the Preparation of the Gifts.

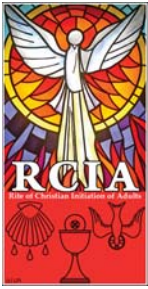

My pastor likes to say that his parents would always remind him to "leave a place you visited a little better than the way you found it." I have always tried to live by those words as well. The important word here is "tried" as I

Jesus speaks to his disciples about this when he urges them to give more than what is asked and to travel two miles in service when all that was required of them is one. 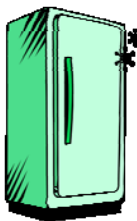
