Consideration of our Christian Commitment: A Lenten Journey

This Sunday as we celebrate the Second Sunday of Lent we take time to renew our (re)Commitment to Ministry. The Lord is transfigured on the mountain in today's Gospel, and through our ministries we have the opportunity to assist him in transfiguring the world. We join in thanking you for your good stewardship and many ministries in the parish and larger community, both the official and unofficial ones.

Last Sunday was another big step for our Candidates and Catechumens. They went to the Cathedral where they



were presented to the Bishop who recognized them as the Elect who would be received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church at Easter, either through Baptism and the other sacraments of initiation or by a Profession of Faith in the Catholic Church, Confirmation and Eucharist.

If last Sunday was another milestone for them, so it was



another milestone for us here in our parish's R.C.I.A. Judy Graphia who became the coordinator of RCIA after Sarah Robinson's retirement, will be resigning her role here in the parish as we near the end of this RCIA year and will be replaced by **Tammy Jackson**. Judy's son has gotten

her a home near her daughter in French Settlement and will be moving out of the parish in a few months. She hopes to be able to remain active in RCIA ministry at St. Joseph's in French Settlement. Tammy Jackson has worked for years with the Apologetics ministry and other forms of adult education, and seems like a natural replacement for Judy. Tammy said her biggest challenge would be not approaching RCIA as she approached her years in the classroom, but I am confident she will do great as she has made the RCIA journey as a sponsor through the years. We thank both Judy and Tammy for their ministries in the parish over the years and wish them God's every blessing in the future.

Mighty Moms now have a new container and new location in the Administration Building. Their old



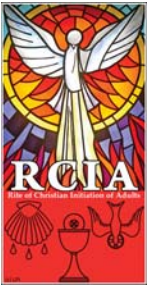

As I write this, Fr. Raj is in the process of moving back. We are still waiting on a few things to be completed and/or delivered, but it is no problem – it gives us something more to look forward to. Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

RCIA—During the season of Lent, we are called to a profound conversion of life. We are called to let God change our hearts, have a greater place in our daily lives, and to remember all that the Lord has done for us. Each Sunday, we have among us a sign of conversion to which the Lord calls us. That sign is our Elect.

Last Sunday, we celebrated with 18 men, women and children their call to conversion and their entrance into a period of intense spiritual preparation during the season of Lent before their participation in the Easter mysteries of baptism, confirmation and Eucharist, entering into full communion with our Catholic community.

PRESENTATION OF THE CREED—We, the Church, hold dear to us two ancient documents of faith and prayer; namely the Creed and the Lord's Prayer. Together these two texts are expressions of our faith in its most condensed and basic form, and they sum up the entirety of our Christian teaching as it is passed on within the community. Handing on our Christian faith is one of our primary responsibilities as Catholic Christians. This Sunday at 9:00 Mass, our community will celebrate the Rite of Presentation of the Creed as we come together to pass on to our Elect this symbol of the faith to which they have been called. Let us pray for the Elect and for our community that God will help each of us take ownership of this beautiful document of faith, to know it, and to cherish its teaching, so that by living it we may become closer to God each day.
