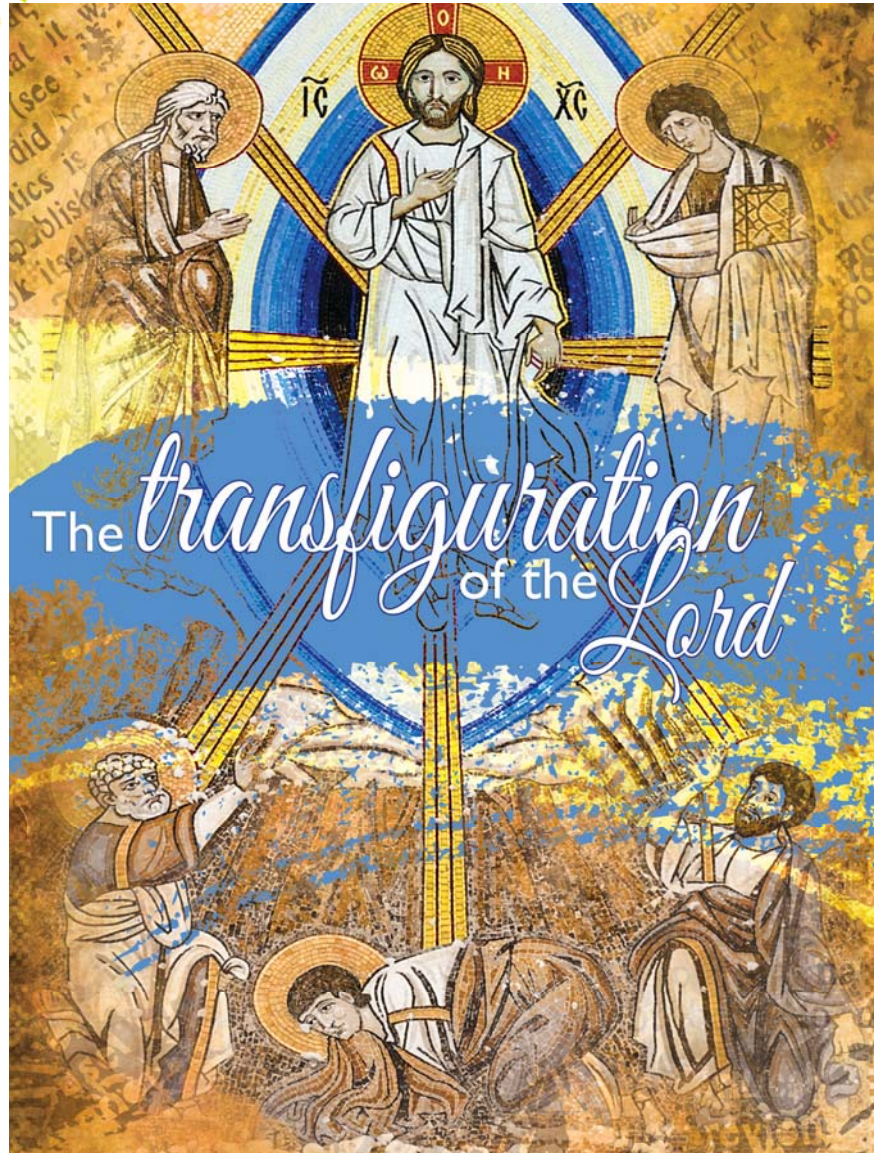

Consideration of our Christian Commitment: Ordinary Time Transfiguration

As we continue through Ordinary Time, the Church pauses today to celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord which normally is celebrated on August 6th.



Scripture scholars teach that the Transfiguration was originally a gift to give the first disciples courage for the trials that lay ahead – the suffering and death of the Lord.

Every Eucharist is meant to be a “Transfiguration/Transforming experience,” for it is in the Eucharist that we encounter the Risen Lord both in word and sacrament.

This is a good time to offer a special word of thanks to all those who serve in Liturgical Ministries here in the parish, from sacristans, to lectors, Eucharistic ministers, altar servers, cantors, choir members and ushers. Last week Deacon Rudy had a training session for new Liturgical

Why does Jesus refer to himself as the “Son of Man”?



In today’s gospel, Jesus again refers to himself as the “Son of Man”, something he does quite frequently in the gospels. In the first reading today, we see to what he is referring. In Daniel’s vision he sees “one like a son of man” descending from heaven on a cloud. He looks like a man but only God would be descending from heaven on a cloud. First century Jews would have seen this as a reference to the coming of the messiah. By giving himself this title, Jesus can imply that he is the messiah without coming out and saying it. An act that would have brought about his execution sooner than he wanted. I’ll bet this drove the Pharisees wild.
