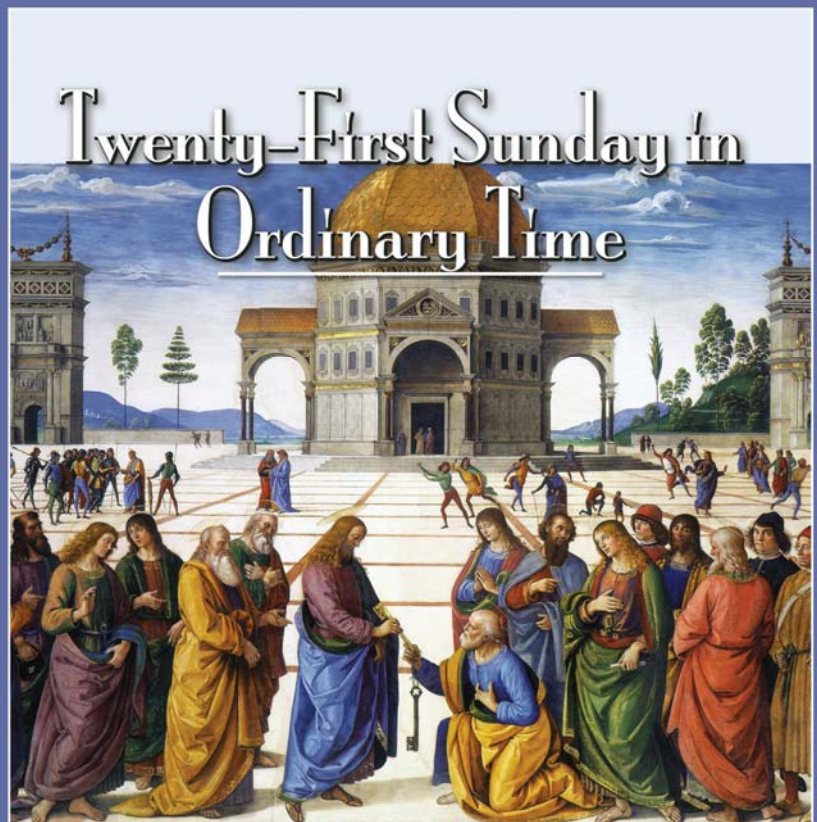

Matthew 16:13-20—How would you answer Jesus' question: "Who do you say that I am?"

Consideration of our Christian Commitment: Ordinary Time Beginnings

As we continue through Ordinary Time, we continue to begin anew for another Pastoral Year. Jesus in the Gospel today tells Peter that he is rock and upon this rock he will build his Church. Peter and the Apostles were the foundation stones, but we are the living stones that through



our ministries continue to build his Church. I thank you for your ministries and all that we are beginning this month.

OUR R.C.I.A. TEAM gathered the beginning of August in preparation for the beginning of the R.C.I.A. Journey, which began 10 August. We were happy to begin August 10, the first night, at which time the team introduced themselves to them and the R.C.I.A. Journey was described to them. **Though the Inquiry process has begun new inquirers will continue to be welcomed to the journey. Anything they have missed can be shared with them.**

Our Confirmation Candidates gathered with parents the beginning of this month to all get on the same page in terms of retreat dates, class schedules, expectations, etc. in



preparation for a good year of growth. We will be celebrating Confirmation here in the parish on Friday, January 19, and we have 71 candidates this year preparing to celebrate the sacrament. Confirmation candidates, sponsors and parents will begin the final months of preparation with the Rite of Enrollment at the Tuesday evening Eucharist, September 12 at 6:00 p.m.

Marriage Preparation is a very important ministry here at Immaculate Conception and we are blessed to have six couples who have participated in a workshop to help them prepare for this ministry at Immaculate Conception. Usually a couple planning marriage meets with one of the priests or

deacons who begins some of the preparation work with them and then assigns them to a sponsor couple who do a FOCCUS, with them. FOCCUS is an instrument which helps couples see how much in agreement they are in terms of important aspects of fulfilling, successful and lifelong marriages. We will continue with this process with them. However a new program for couples to work with has recently been recommended by the Diocese and it is called Prepare/Enrich. It also is a very good program and there will be a workshop on Saturday, September 16, from 9:00 a.m. till 4:00 for couples wishing to join in ministry to couples about to be married. It will be at the Catholic Life Center and Immaculate Conception will be happy to take care of any registration fees, etc. to help couples acquire the skills in this ministry. **Any interested in more information or to register are asked to telephone Fr. Frank or Deacon Rudy at 665-5359.** We would be happy to answer any questions.

Fr. Raj left on vacation days last Monday and will be returning to the parish September 7. Let us keep him in our prayers that he had good and relaxing days with family who are in the United States. Taking his place at 9:00 and 11:00 this Sunday is Fr. Joel LaBauve who was baptized with me at the old St. Agnes Church downtown (where the interstate is now). He is retired and lives here in the parish. Next week, Fr. Nutan from Our Lady of Mercy will take the 9:00 Eucharist for him.

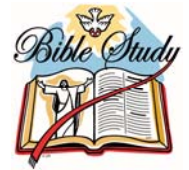

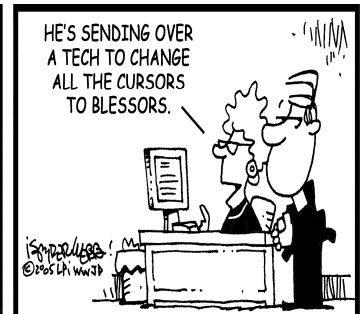


Is the Pope always right?
