CONSIDERATION OF OUR CHRISTIAN COMMITMENT: RETURN TO ORDINARY

Today's Gospel reminds us of how God anticipates our needs. In the first reading, the Prophet Elijah reaches out to the woman who is grieving the loss of her son. In the Gospel, Jesus sees the widow grieving over the loss of her son, and reaches out to them, restoring him to her. No one had approached him with a request. He reached out to them first. It is a good reminder of the Provident Love of God reaching out to us all, sometimes before we even call upon him. To me it is one of the wonderful things in our Christian lives – to be able to look back and see how God was loving and watching over us before we even thought to ask for help, sometimes before we even realized we needed it. We look back and realize that God was loving and watching out for us before we even realized the need, much less called on God for help. That's how good Fathers (and Mothers) respond to us in our need.

We have begun the month of June, but as we began the month of May, we began it with our May Crowning at the 4:00 Anticipated Eucharist. Pictured

Thursday night in August, I was hungry for answers. I realized I wasn't going to receive all the answers that night. Throughout the process, I learned more than I thought I would coming into the RCIA process. All of my questions were answered and more. During the Rite of the Elect when Bishop Muench prayed for us and the names were called out, this moment made me feel the unity of faith. I had never felt such warmth and feelings among all the different nationalities at one time. Last weekend, when I was baptized at the Easter Vigil, was overwhelming. I had the Holy Spirit racing through my body because I felt my emotions like never before (excitement, joy, nervousness, stomach, fingers, etc.). My sponsor reminded me as we walked to the front of the church after baptism that my sins had been washed away, and I was just lost for words and I just continued to pray and thanked Jesus for all he has done in my life to get me here today. When I finally (because it seems like it's been forever for me) was able to join in during communion it was absolutely beautiful. I had so many thoughts flowing through my mind, such great and beautiful images, all at the same time. This isn't everything I feel about my experience because it would take too long for me to write it all. But my experience is and was life changing in the best way!
