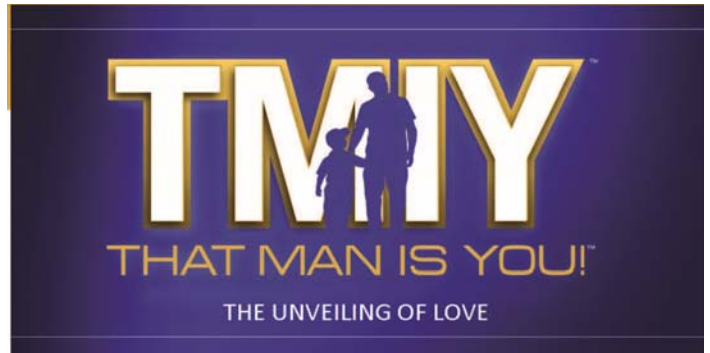

Consideration of our Christian Commitment: Ordinary Time Beginnings

This Sunday as we celebrate the Labor Day Weekend, the Scriptures remind us that sacrifice is almost always required in order to accomplish things that are really important. “No pain, no gain”, is a common phrase we hear often, but it holds true with regard to growing in our love for the Lord and living as faithful disciples. In the Gospel today, Jesus teaches that whoever wishes to follow him must take up their cross and follow him. This leaves no room for doubt that sacrifice is a fundamental requirement for being a faithful disciple. I read something some time back that really impressed me. It went, **“Jesus is not looking for fans. He is looking for followers.”** We thank all those who through their own sacrifices are helping us begin a new Pastoral Year in a beautiful and graced way.

Children’s church begins next Sunday at the 11:00 Eucharist. We welcome new leaders and helpers who will be assisting with the weekly schedule this ministry year. We welcome assistance. Just call the parish office if you have questions about it. It’s a beautiful ministry which many of our younger parishioners really enjoy and get a lot out of.

On September 14, there will be an informational meeting at 7:00 p.m. in Room 1 for those who wish to take the trip to attend and participate in the March for Life, January 16-20 in Washington, D.C. Every year this has been a popular trip with youth from around the Diocese. Participating in the trip will be youth from the Diocese of Baton Rouge, many of our seminarians, as well as youth ministers and advisors. Representing our parish in terms of helping organize our participation will be Jessica Cowart who has attended many of these trips in past years. This year we have extra places to fill because we will be celebrating Confirmation on January 19, 2018, when the March for Life trip will be happening. This Thursday, September 7, the parish offices and the Faith Formation Center offices will be closed for the day so that our staff may attend a day of reflection and prayer as we begin this new pastoral year. It will be held at the Catholic Life Center and the presenter will be Becky Eldridge -author, mother, and theologian - and the theme of the day will be **“Living as Missionary Disciples.”** This is a day of reflection and prayer for catechists in parish schools of religion, but we thought it would be good for the entire staff as well as catechists, as a lot of evangelization takes

place in the offices as well as the classrooms. The Diocese asked me to celebrate the Eucharist for those attending at 8:30, so Fr. Robert Stine, a retired priest of the Diocese living in the parish, has agreed to preside over the Eucharist here. Please keep us in your prayers this Thursday.

This coming Saturday, September 9, will be our first Confirmation Retreat. It will be at Angola and will end with the Anticipated Eucharist which I will celebrate with them and the Trustees who will have given the retreat. Let us keep our candidates in prayer as they continue on these last months of their journey toward Confirmation.

How many times can I go to Communion each day?

A Catholic is allowed to receive Holy Communion twice a day; however, the second reception needs to be during a Mass. Canon 917 states “A person who has already received the Most Holy Eucharist can receive it a second time on the day only within the Eucharistic celebration [the Mass] in which the person participates.” Church authority has interpreted “a second time” to NOT mean “again and again”. The purpose of this is twofold: to promote active participation in the Mass and to avoid receiving multiple communions out of superstition, ignorance or misguided religious zeal. This rule is waived for clergy celebrating multiple Masses.
