## Consideration of our Christian Commitment: Ordinary Time Catechesis

**This Sunday the Scriptures** urge us to make forgiveness a part of our lives, a forgiveness that opens us up to all God would share. It's hard to receive when our hearts and minds are closed because we are holding on to things we should let go of.

**Today is Catechetical Sunday** and we give thanks to God for all those involved in Catechetical Ministry in the parish. The theme for Catechetical Sunday this year is given to us by the Bishops of the United States and it is "Living as Missionary Disciples." This Sunday, those who have offered their time and talent to serve as

catechists in our Parish Schools of Religion will be called forth to be commissioned for their ministry. Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of Baptism, in handing on the faith

and being a witness to the Gospel. Catechetical Sunday is an opportunity for all to rededicate themselves to this mission as a community of faith. The first week of

September the staff gathered for a Day of Reflection and Prayer with those catechists who were able to come. The theme of the day was "Living as Missionary Disciples," the Catechetical Sunday theme.

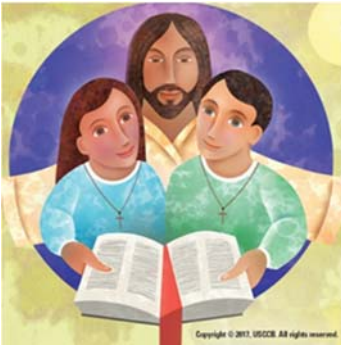
**This week Fr. Raj and I will be in New Orleans Tuesday-Thursday for the "Louisiana Priests' Convention."** This was begun a number of years ago and is held in New Orleans every three to five years. It takes the place of our Diocesan Formation Days usually held in January. Because it involves priests from all over the state, it is much larger and they are able to get really top notch speakers to come and conduct sessions and workshops for

us. Following the convention, I will be taking my last vacation days of the year from Friday, September 22nd through Friday, September 29<sup>th</sup>. As I write this, I don't have special plans to go here or there, but more than likely will be going somewhere, as vacation days don't usually work out that well for me at home. Whatever or wherever, it will be good. When I return on the 29<sup>th</sup>, I will be here for the weekend, then leaving with Fr. Raj for the priests' retreat at Manresa.

**I would like to call to the attention of anyone who has recently dealt with a divorce a special program called Journey of Hope.** *Journey of Hope* is a special program addressing the concerns of separated and/or divorced Catholics. The program offers support and addresses important issues that arise as a result of a divorce. The strong emphasis on prayer, scripture and Church teachings leads to healing and a better relationship with Christ. Sessions begin Sunday, Sept. 24 at St. Aloysius. **Assistance for hurricane and flood victims:** Last week we took a collection for victims of Hurricane Harvey and flooding in Louisiana and Texas which totaled over \$20,000! I thought this was almost like the "widow's mite" from the Gospel, given all we have been through. You make me so proud to be your pastor. As of this writing (September 12), I am not sure if there will be another collections for victims of Hurricane Irma or if the Bishop will divide last week's collection between Catholic Charities in the different affected dioceses. We are still collecting water and cleaning supplies in the coffee room, and those going to either places have been bringing whatever is collected with them. If you are going to effected areas to the east or west, you are welcome to come and see what we have.

**In January, I reported to you results of biopsies** which indicated the prostate cancer that had been first diagnosed January, 2016, was very aggressive and growing fast. After a bone scan indicated it had not spread, doctors decided the best route was radiation combined with shots to reduce the size of the tumors. I finished the 43 radiation treatments the end of May and the doctors said all indications confirmed that while the cancer was still there, it posed no more danger for years to come. They said if I remained in aftercare for another year, receiving the shots every six months, they could get rid of the cancer for good. So this is what is happening. The side effects of the radiation and shots were minimal and so far, so good. Thanks again for your prayer and concern. Let us keep each other and all suffering from storms and flooding in prayer. In the first year of his pontificate, Pope Francis spoke to catechists and said, "The heart of a catechist always beats with this systolic and diastolic movement: union with Christ—encounter with others. Both of these: I am one with Jesus and I go forth to encounter others. If one of these movements is missing, the heart no longer beats, it can no longer live. The heart of the catechist receives the gift of the kerygma, and in turn offers it to others as a gift. What a little word: "gift"! The catechist is conscious of having received a gift, the gift of faith, and he or she then gives that gift in turn to others. This is something beautiful. We don't keep a percentage for ourselves! Whatever we receive, we give! This is not commerce! It is not a business! It is pure gift: a gift received and a gift given. And the catechist is right there, at the center of this exchange of gifts. (Kerygma—The proclamation of Jesus' teachings).
