Consideration of our Christian Commitment: Ordinary Time Respect

This Sunday in our second reading St. Paul tells us to make our requests known to God. "then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." With that in mind, I would like to share a beautiful meditation below.

Fr. Pedro Arrupe, S.J., was born in 1907 and ministered



in so many ways over the years of his life, we could write volumes on him. He was born in Spain, studied to be a doctor, then joined the Jesuits, ministered as a missionary in Japan, was imprisoned by the Japanese during World War II, witnessed first hand the bombing of Hiroshima, ministering to

the casualties, and then served as Superior General of the Jesuits from 1966 until 1983. He died in 1991, and was a fantastic priest, Christian, missionary, leader, whatever he was called to be. He led the Jesuits through the years of change after the Second Vatican Council, and I remember when I was in the seminary and in my earlier days as a priest, his name was always coming up in the news and in different writings. Over the years I read some of his writings, but a few weeks ago I came across his prayer from, Finding God In All Things, which I hadn't read in years. I thought this might be a good time to share it with you:

Nothing is more practical than finding God, Than falling in Love in a quite absolute, final way. What you are in love with, what seizes your imagination, will affect everything. It will decide what will get you out of bed in the morning, what you do with your evenings, how you spend your weekends, what you read, whom you know, what breaks your heart, and what amazes you with joy and gratitude. Fall in love, stay in love, and it will decide everything.

Stump the Deacon!

**Why do I have to confess my sins to a priest? Can't I go directly to God?**

After His resurrection from the dead, Jesus met with His disciples and instituted the sacrament of reconciliation when He told them “Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.” (Jn 20:23) In doing this, Christ allowed the forgiveness of sins through the Apostles and their successors (the bishops) and their assistants (priests). He would not have instituted this sacrament if He did not want it to be used here on earth; He intended that our sins be forgiven by celebrating this sacrament. God can forgive our sins outside of confession, but only if we make a PERFECT act of contrition. Perfect contrition is sorrow for our offenses primarily because of our love for God and because our sins violated God and that love, not because we deserve punishment. Are we confident that we can make a perfect act of contrition? How would we be sure that God has forgiven us? Confession of sins to a priest gives us the assurance that our sins are forgiven, even though we may not be a perfect penitent. We also receive sacramental graces through this sacrament, and during our confession, the priest may be able to give us sound, objective advice in analyzing our sins and how to avoid them in the future. What a bonus that can be!
